ITALIAN WHITES

Prosecco, Lamberti (Italy)

Floral aromas with peach and tropical fruit notes mark this delicious Prosecco. Lively and effervescent, the palate is clean and crisp with balanced acidity and a lingering finish.

Moscato, Pellegrino Zebo (Italy)

Zebo Moscato is an extremely refreshing lightly sparkling wine with notes of fresh nectarine, melon and white peach. Delicate, slightly sweet with a long lingering finish.

Pinot Grigio, Donini (Italy)

Donini Pinot Grigio has a distinctive bouquet of wild flowers and hints of honey and fruit. In the mouth the wine is dry, and light with clean, lively apple and pear fruit.

Pinot Grigio 'Sortesele', Santi (Italy)

With a pale straw color and delicate green tints, the wine has full and complex aromas of pears, exotic fruits and wild flowers. On the palate, the wine has generous, soft but lively fruit with firm flavors, good acidity and a long finish. The wine has fine structure, captivating to the nose and very satisfying on the palate.

WHITES

White Zinfandel, Beringer (California) Fresh and delicious with berry-like fruit flavors and citrus fruit notes.

Chardonnay, Astica (Argentina)

Fresh and pleasant, with a soft, round finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Kato (New Zealand)

This Kato Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc shows lifted tropical notes of guava and stone fruit. The palate is crisp, fruity and fresh and finishes with a lively, citrus acidity.

Riesling, 'Steinbock', Dr. Fischer (Germany)

Sourced exclusively from Mosel Valley, this riesling is outstanding. Off-dry and very aromatic, with great crisp acidity and a long finish.

Chardonnay, Kendall Jackson (California)

Tasty tropical flavors such as mango, papaya and pineapple with citrus notes, delicately intertwine with aromas of green apple and pear to create depth and balance throughout. A hint of toasted oak rounds out the finish.

ROSÉS

Pinot Noir Rosé, Attitude by Pascal Jolivet (France)

A blend of Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc, and Gamay. Brilliant, pure pink in color. The three varietal blend comes together to form a wine of medium body, fleshy fruit, herbs and plum.

ITALIAN REDS

Chianti 'Borghi D'Elsa', Melini (Italy)

Borghi D'Elsa has intense, fragrant and elegant aromas of blackberries and raspberries, with violet and Florentine iris notes. On the palate, the taste is dry, full, harmonious and slightly tannic, with an elegant aftertaste of toasted almond and fruits of the forest.

Pinot Noir, Donini (Italy)

Ruby red in color with a very distinct bouquet of black currants and spices. An attractive, dry and savory flavor well balanced with a finish of jammy fruit and toasted nuts.

Lambrusco, Riunite (Italy)

Lively red/violet reflections. Fruity, soft and harmonious. Light and well-balanced on the palate.

Chianti Classico, Ruffino (Italy)

Sweet cherry and red berry fruit. It's well balanced on the palate, with velvety tannins.

REDS

Cabernet Sauvignon, Astica (Argentina)

Blackberry aroma with a smooth fruity palate.

Merlot, Grayson Cellars (California)

The Grayson Merlot is sumptuous and rich with a beautiful purple garnet color. The aromas show rich complexity of black cherry preserves, currant and white chocolate. This is a magnificently decadent Merlot that finishes with soft tannins, dark fruits and elaborate oak.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Josh Cellars (California)

The bouquet is rich with dark fruits, cinnamon, clove and subtle oak aromas. The wine is juicy on the palate with bright red cherries and blackberry flavors prominent, accented by delicate vanilla flavors and toasty oak, finishing long with round, soft tannins.

Pinot Noir, Hanging Vine (California)

Light to medium body with bing cherry, asian spice, and bright acidity. This is not a Syrah-inflicted Pinot Noir, so expect true Pinot Noir expression and character.

Red Blend, The Cleaver, Renwood (California)

Deep and dark, The Cleaver is a dense, rich and powerful wine. It is silky smooth and coats the palate with intensely concentrated flavors of black plum and blackberry jam. Threads of acidity pace from front to back, balancing the heavy weight and volume of this wine.

Malbec Estate, El Esteco (Argentina)

Dark violet in color with a rich nose of berry, coffee and herbs. Mature and vibrant notes combined with firm and sweet tannins. Long persistence, concentrated and elegant.
